Purpose of Decision	To determine, in accordance with the Localism Act 2011, the application by Charlbury Town Council for Charlbury Parish to be designated as a Neighbourhood Area.

Reasons	<p>In the Council's opinion, the application for the Designation of the Charlbury Neighbourhood Area, the boundary of which follows the boundary of Charlbury Parish, is appropriate for the purposes of producing a Neighbourhood Plan for Charlbury Parish.</p> <p>The application has been open for consultation for six weeks in accordance with associated Regulations. The adjacent Parish Councils of Finstock, Stonefield and Spelsbury, and Cornbury and Wychwood Parish Meeting were notified of the consultation. No objections were received. Oxfordshire County Council was also notified of the application and an endorsement of the Neighbourhood Area Designation was received on 8th September 2014.</p> <p>The application for the Designation of a Neighbourhood Area for Charlbury Parish was assessed against the requirements set in the Localism Act 2011 and associated Regulations/ Government Guidance in terms of the eligibility of the nomination. The application was submitted by Charlbury Town Council which is the only body eligible to submit an application within the Parish.</p>
